

**COFFEE BOARD : BENGALURU****DIRECT RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF EXTENSION INSPECTOR ('TECHNICAL')  
IN TERMS OF THE COFFEE BOARD (CADRE & RECRUITMENT) RULES**

1. **Name of the Post :** Extension Inspector ('Technical' - Group 'C').
2. **Number of Posts:** 30\* (Thirty).
3. **Reservation:**  
(i) SC – 4 (ii) ST –3 (iii) OBC – 12 (iv) EWS – Nil and (v) Unreserved – 11  
\* Of the 30 posts (vacancies) 3 vacancies are reserved for Ex-servicemen.
4. **Level in Pay Matrix (7<sup>th</sup> CPC):** Level – 5
5. **Educational Qualification:**  
**Essential:** Graduation in Agricultural or Horticultural Sciences or Graduation in Science with Botany or Zoology as one of the subjects.
6. **Age Limit (Calculated as on 01.01.2025):** Between 18 and 27 years. 5 years relaxation is given to SC/ST, 3 years for OBC, 5 years age relaxation for in-service or departmental candidates. For PwBD & Ex-Servicemen candidates, age relaxation shall be as per the guidelines issued by the DoP&T, Government of India from time to time.
7. **Period of Probation:** TWO years.
8. **Confirmation:** The confirmation of the newly recruited Personnel will be subject to satisfactory completion of **TWO** years' probation period.
9. **Location/Place of Posting:** Coffee Board's Research Stations/Technology Evaluation Centres/in any of the Coffee Board's offices located all over India.
10. **Selection Procedure:** Selection will be made based on the educational qualification and experience as described below:

(II)	<b>Experience: 20 Marks</b> Experience in Transfer of Technology or related areas in Agricultural sector either in Govt., or Private organizations (2 marks per year limited to a maximum of 20 Marks)	20
(III)	<b>Publications: 10 Marks</b> In Agriculture Research or Extension Journals / Articles in Magazines or Newspaper on Agriculture Sector (1 Mark for each publication. Maximum 10 Marks)	10
