


COFFEE BOARD : BENGALURU**DIRECT RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF JUNIOR LIAISON OFFICER ('TECHNICAL')
IN TERMS OF THE COFFEE BOARD (CADRE & RECRUITMENT) RULES**

1. **Name of the Post :** Junior Liaison Officer ('Technical' - Group 'B').
2. **Number of Posts:** 13 (Thirteen).
3. **Reservation:**
(i) SC – 2 (ii) ST – Nil (iii) OBC – 3 (iv) EWS – 1 and (v) Unreserved – 7.
4. **Level in Pay Matrix (7th CPC):** Level – 6.
5. **Educational Qualification:**
Essential: 1st Class Graduate in Agriculture or Horticulture, preferably with specialization in Agricultural Extension, preferably M.Sc., (Ag) in Agricultural Extension.
6. **Age Limit (Calculated as on 01.01.2025):** Maximum 30 years. Further, 5 years age relaxation is given to SC, 3 years for OBC, 5 years age relaxation is given to in-service or departmental candidates. For PwBD & Ex-Servicemen candidates, age relaxation shall be as per the guidelines issued by the DoP&T, Government of India from time to time.
7. **Period of Probation:** TWO years.
8. **Confirmation:** The confirmation of the newly recruited Personnel will be subject to satisfactory completion of **TWO** years' probation period.
9. **Location/Place of Posting:** Coffee Board's Research Stations/Technology Evaluation Centres/in any of the Coffee Board's offices located all over India.
10. **Selection Procedure:** Selection will be made based on the educational qualification and experience as described below:

Sl. No.	Criteria	Allocation of Marks
(I)	Post Graduation - M.Sc. (Ag.). in Agricultural Extension Please Note: Weightage of marks obtained will be calculated using factor of 0.2. (The percentage of total marks obtained multiplied by 0.2)	20
(II)	Graduation - B.Sc. (Ag.) 1 st Class Graduate in Agriculture or Horticulture. Please Note: Weightage of marks obtained will be calculated using factor of 0.5. (The percentage of total marks obtained multiplied by 0.5)	50
(III)	Experience: (a) In Agriculture Research and Teaching - One mark for every completed year of experience with a maximum of 10 marks	10
	(b) In Agriculture Extension work at Government or Private Sector - One mark for every completed year of experience with a maximum of 10 marks	10
(IV)	Publications - In Research or Extension Journals / Articles in Magazines / Newspapers on agriculture sector (1 Mark for each publication. Maximum 10 Marks)	10
